The apprentice's entry-level rate is based on a percentage of the Journeyman rate of \$22.85 per hour and may increase every 6 months if qualified. Minimum qualifications for entry into the Program are: Must be age 18 or over, must be a high school graduate or have GED, must be physically fit to perform the work of the trade, and must have military discharge under other than dishonorable conditions (if applicable). Applications will be accepted 5 days per week, except holidays between the hours of 9-11:30am and 1:30-3pm at the contractor/employer address.
